Work Ready will give you new skills and qualifications, renewed confidence and extra support. Your benefits will not be affected, and if you are eligible, you could receive money to help pay for travel and childcare support.

If you are 18 or over and are unemployed and receiving benefits from the Department for Work and Pensions, then Work Ready is a great opportunity to get you into work or onto further learning.

By assessing your needs, Work Ready can be tailored to suit you. There are two levels available:

Learning for Work

Learning for Work is a part-time course that runs for a maximum of 24 weeks. It supports you with basic skills and confidence building. You can try out different jobs and get involved in community projects and voluntary work.

Best of all, you will achieve new qualifications and receive the very best training.

Routeways

Routeways is a full-time course that will run for a maximum of 10 working days. It will provide you with the training you need to get working and start earning. We have worked with employers to ensure the skills you get are the skills they need.

It's important that you know what type of work you would like to do before your training starts. If you need extra skills, then this will be taken care of by your training provider.

Best of all, once you've completed your training, you should be offered a job interview if an employer can be found.
